### William Claiborne

In 1997, then President of the National Society of Claiborne Descendants, Tom Claiborne, made the following remarks at the unveiling in Hampton Virginia of a marker memorializing William Claiborne's life in the new world. "We are all proud to be descendants of William Claiborne. He was the quintessential immigrant. He was ambitious, courageous, driven, honorable, bold and creative. He and his peers formed the model if immigration that has made this country so great...We are the legacy of William Claiborne's dream."

The Society was formed in 1988 and continues to grow and share in the knowledge of the Claiborne-Cliborn clan. On a biennial basis, we hold a reunion in order that far flung descendants can come together and commune on their common genealogy and further friendships.

## 2011 Claiborne Clan Reunion: New Orleans - September 29 to October 2, 2011
